

REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES

The Southeast Missouri Regional Port Authority requests qualifications for construction engineering services for the Southeast Missouri Regional Port Authority (Semo Port) Railroad Mainline Improvements.

The project consists of two parts: raising approximately 2,500 track feet of mainline 12 inches and replacing 500 railroad ties.

The project is located in Cape Girardeau County on property owned by Semo Port.

Information provided to the Port Authority must include:

- 1) The capacity and capability of the firm in performing similar work on projects within the past five years;
- 2) The record of the firm on factors as cost control, quality of work, and ability to meet schedules;
- 3) Design and construction of railroad tracks;
- 4) Provide the geographic location of the firm relative to the Semo Port's location and familiarity with the project and location. The firm should include a street address of the office(s) proposed to handle this work;
- 5) References from previous clients during the past five years; and
- 6) Documentation of compliance with E-Verify requirements;

The firm will be selected based on the above qualifications.

The above information should be submitted no later than April 8, 2020, 11:00 A.M. to Southeast Missouri Regional Port Authority, 10 Bill Bess Drive, Scott City, MO 63780.
